

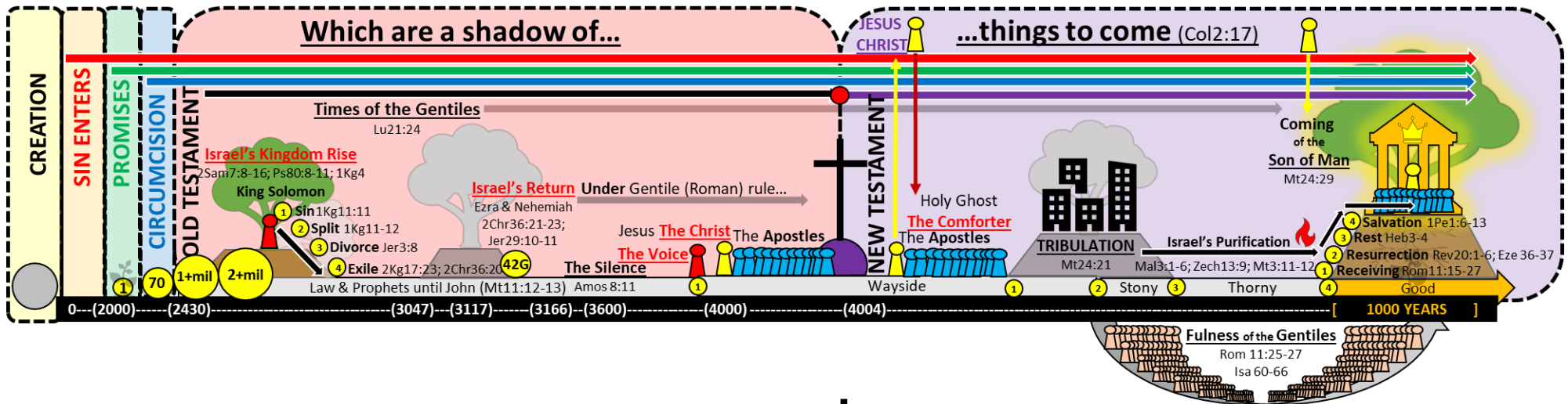


# FUNDAMENTAL GRACE BIBLE STUDY

## The Parable of the Mustard Seed (Mt13:31-32; Mk4:30-32 \*Dispensationally Considered)

Christ's earthly ministry consisted of confirming the promises made to Israel's fathers, calling out faithful Israel and equipping them with the New Covenant Holy Spirit, purchased by his blood. "The parable of the mustard seed" describes the origin, position, dominion and destiny of Israel's new testament kingdom above all other nations on earth as the city on a hill. (See Matthew – Acts 1-8; Hebrews – the Revelation).

**Note:** This image *omits the revelation of the mystery of Christ's body*, given to the apostle Paul (Ac9:1-6; 26:15-18; Rom16:25; Gal1-2; 6:15; Eph1-3; Col1:25-27; 1Cor2:6-8; 9:17 1Tim1:15-16; 2:4-7; 2Tim1:9-12; Ti1:1-3).
