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## **Paul's Ministry Timeline**

Timeline: ~22 years after Christ's sending (Acts 9)

Biblical: After Acts 19:21 & before Acts 20:6

Location: Macedonia or Achaia (Rom15:25-26; 16:23)

Outline: Ch. 1-3 (Sin); 4-5 (Salvation); 6-8 (Service or Walk); 9-11 (Israel); 12-16 (Practical)

Conversion – Jerusalem (3 years)

Tarsus – Antioch (1 year)

Antioch – Jerusalem (13 years)

Jerusalem – Corinth (1.5 years)

Corinth – Ephesus (2 years, 3 months + a season = 3 yrs.)

Macedonia - Greece (3 months)

Greece – Jerusalem (1 month?)
